### 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Pencils (solid wood #2 OR mechanical w/ lead)
- 2 Red AND 2 Black medium ballpoint pens
- Eraser (Pink Pearl is preferred)
- Ruler
- Scissors (Children's fiskars are the best)
- 1 Loose-leaf binder AND a set of dividers (not for Reeves)
- 200 Count Loose-leaf paper (college ruled)
- 2 boxes of facial tissue
- 1 pencil box OR loose-leaf pencil bag
- White glue OR glue sticks
- Crayons (small box of 24 is sufficient)
- 1 set of color felt-tipped markers (water based) (Not for Reeves)
- 1 solar powered calculator for Math and ISAT testing
- 1 box of colored pencils (12 count or more)
- Protractor
- Please resupply paper & red pens through year.

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

- 7 spiral notebooks (college ruled) No Perforated Paper, please.
- 1 ruler w/ inches & centimeters marked
- 2 or 3 Pink Pearl Erasers
- 1 small pair of scissors
- #2 pencils
- Black or blue pens
- 2 glue sticks

### 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

- We request that all students bring 2 boxes of facial tissue give to your 1<sup>st</sup> hour teacher.
- Reading: Please bring a pocket folder. Teachers may also request additional supplies since our reading program will be different than in the past.
- Math: Calculator for Math and ISAT testing (no fraction for 7<sup>th</sup> - fractions okay for 8<sup>th</sup>), pencil, paper, 1 3-prong folder, ruler, compass, protractor (7<sup>th</sup> only), book cover, red pen, facial tissue
- Science: Pencil, pens, and paper everyday, a box of facial tissue, book cover, calculator, notebook (one specifically for Science), four 3-ring (1"-1 1/2") binders for portfolios (7<sup>th</sup> grade only), 1 pack 3x5 note cards (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)
- Social Studies: One 3-ring binder that is at least 1" wide, dividers, paper, pencil, pen, colored pencils/crayons, book cover
- 7<sup>th</sup> Health: One 3-ring binder that is at least 1" wide, dividers, paper, pencil, pen, colored pencils/crayons, book cover, box of facial tissue
- Language Arts: One medium 3-ring binder to be used exclusively for this class only, six dividers, college ruled paper, pocket folder w/ three holes to keep in binder, zipper pouch that has three holes to keep in binder, 3 red pencils or pens, lots of #2 pencils (mechanical ones work the best; bring a supply of lead), high-lighters, book cover, set of 12 colored pencils, notebook for Mt. Language & DOL, 2 book covers
- Ball/Life Skills: T-shirt and shorts to dress down every day (not dressing down lowers your grade), tennis shoes w/ non-marking sole, deodorant, clean socks, a combination lock will be provided by school - or feel free to purchase your own lock for P.E locker. No key locks are allowed.
- Choir: Pocket folder, paper, and pencils
- Spanish: 3x5 cards, notebook, pencil, pen, book cover, Ziploc bags, facial tissue
- Crafts: \$10 class fee
- Advanced Tech: Jump drive
- Pre-Driver's Training (elective) Notebook, pen, pencil, 3-prong folder w/ pockets
- All other classes (Drama, Computer Applications, Intro to FCS, & Intro to Ag): Pen, pencil and notebook
